### Moles

The presence of moles may be indicated by a network of surface ridges in the turf, by a series of cone-shaped mounds, or by damage to bulbs.

**Treating Mounds:** Remove the center plug from each mound. Drop a teaspoon amount of oat bait into the underground tunnel. Close the opening and don't allow loose dirt to cover the bait. If mole activity persists, a second treatment may be made.

**Treating Surface Ridges:** Only treat active burrows. Punch a hole in the top of active tunnels and drop a teaspoon of oat bait into the underground tunnel. Close the opening and don't allow loose dirt to cover the bait. After 2-3 days, check to see if the burrows are still active. If so, repeat the treatment.

For control of moles in lawns, golf courses and other non-crop areas. All bait applications in these areas must be applied manually (by gloved hand or with a hand probe). Collect and bury all dead animals.

### Pocket Gophers

Burrowing pocket gophers throw out low, fan shaped dirt mounds on either side of their underground tunnels. Lateral tunnels coming to the surface on the flat side of the fan are plugged with soil. Carefully remove the plug. With a long handled spoon, insert a teaspoon of oat bait as far down as possible. Re-close the opening, being careful not to disturb the bait.

For control of gophers in lawns, golf courses and other non-crop areas. All bait applications in these areas must be applied directly into underground tunnels made by gophers. All bait must be applied manually (by gloved hand or with a hand probe). Collect and bury all dead animals found.
